- Mountain biking on the farm and surrounds

Child Policy:

Due to the fact that the camp is located on coastal cliffs we have the following child policy in place:

- **Parents take full responsibility for children at all times.**
- No babysitting facilities are on offer
- Children 13 and up to pay full adult rate and occupy their own tents.
- Children 0 – 5 years: no children under 5 years
- Children 5 – 12 years: R 500 per child per night – dinner and breakfast
- Maximum of 1 additional child per tent

The Glamping Tents:

Our canvas safari lodge type tents are spacious and practical for the coastal setting. Each tent sleeps 2 people in twin beds - some can be converted into queen beds. The tents are furnished with proper beds, coil mattresses, comfy duvets and blankets. Additional furnishings include 2 x camping chairs to enjoy the amazing view, bed side table, cupboard, solar light and camping lamp. Each tent has its own private ablution facility with a bucket shower, chemical toilet and a basin (Soap, shampoo and towels provided.) Your hot shower will be brought to your ablution at your convenience.

A turn down service is provided with hot water bottles if the evenings are cool.

At Witsand we have made every effort to keep each tent as private as possible for the ultimate remote experience. Tents are spaced well apart each with a extra special view.





Meals:

Breakfast and dinner are included in our rate and is served buffet style in our dining tent that overlooks the ocean.

Breakfast consists of a buffet continental and plated cooked breakfast served with fruit juice and coffee or tea.

Dinners are 2 courses with a buffet main meal and plated dessert. We don't serve fancy food just lekker and plentiful food - two meats, vegetables, salad and starch. Please notify us upon booking regarding any dietary requirements.

We do have a lunch menu - lunch bookings can be made at breakfast in order for the kitchen to prepare.

Getting to Witsand Glamping Experience:

Upon booking full instructions will be sent to clients with directions to get to us. About 2km before arriving in Witsand (R322) turn onto a farm road for 9 km to get to the camp. A vehicle with good ground clearance is recommended but any car can access us.

Check in and out times:

Check in time is from 14h00 onward – it is recommended to arrive by 5pm in time to settle in and enjoy the sunset before dinner which is served at 8pm in summer and 7pm in winter. It is not ideal to arrive after dark.

Check out time is 10 am

WiFi and cell phone reception:

There is limited Wifi available when the generator is on, there is also cell reception but it can be patchy.

Power supply:

We always try to run our camps as eco-friendly as possible and therefore we run our fridges and freezers on solar power, we do have generator power in the morning and evening so guests can charge their phones / cameras in the lounge tent. There are no power points in the tents but there are solar lights

Drinking water:

Our camp's water is from a borehole which is safe to drink - you are welcome to bring along your own water if you wish.

Bar:

No alcohol will be sold at our Witsand camp - Ice and soft drinks and bar snacks will be on sale.

You are welcome to bring along your own alcohol.



What to do while at Remote Locations Witsand:

We have access to **2 private beaches** – one right in front of the main area stretch tent and one 2 km east from the main area. (a sedan cannot drive to the second beach)

There are no lifeguards on duty – please choose a swimming spot carefully. On low tide there are rock pools to swim in and on high tide you can still swim at certain spots, be careful of the rocks.

Shore angling is huge in this area – if you an avid fisherman try your hand at fishing.

Trail runners / hikers and mountain bikers can have a field day here – we have private access to 14km of farm roads on our property alone, and more outside the property.

Plant enthusiasts / botanists: explore the coastal fynbos on the farm

Birders: the birding is exceptional here with many sea birds and birds of prey.

Whales: St Sebastian Bay is known as the whale nursery. From July to September every year the whales frolic in the waters right in front of the camp providing hours of entertainment.
